




Pennsylvania Act 153 Clearance & Submission Process

The process defined on this diagram is for typical event volunteers. MAR will also accept equivalent clearances for Pennsylvania school teachers (PA Act 151 & 114).

Disclosure: MAR understands that personal information is provided on clearances. MAR will take all measures to keep documents secure. MAR will not accept, store, or scan any documents electronically.

Clearances Process

MAR Event Volunteer secures hard copies of MAR Act 153 Cover Sheet / Clearances / Affidavits / Reimbursement Forms.

Representatives from MAR collect hard copies at Designated Off-Season Events, Local Kickoffs, Drop-off Locations listed on the MAR website, or in last resort at MAR FRC District Events. A central database documents that a volunteer has submitted the required clearances and the expiration date of the clearances. Clearances are valid for 60 months from date of issuances.

Hard copies are stored in locked drop boxes. Only representatives from MAR will have access to drop box contents.

Pennsylvania Event Volunteer Coordinators will cross-check the database to ensure all event volunteers have complied with the requirements of Act 153.

At the conclusion of FRC Season, the drop boxes are emptied, reimbursements are issued, and clearances are sent to a secure document storage facility (i.e. Iron Mountain).
